West Feliciana Parish Hospital to underwrite five Saints games on KPCP

West Feliciana Parish Hospital will be the exclusive underwriter for five West Feliciana High School home football games that will be broadcast over KPCP 88.3 in New Roads. Play-by-play and commentary will be handled by long-time radio personality Clarence Buggs. Pre-game will begin at 6:45 p.m. followed by kickoff at 7 p.m. for each contest.

“To support our high school, we are happy to underwrite these broadcasts,” said Hospital CEO Lee Chastant III. “We saw the amazing community support when we sponsored the Livonia playoff game last season and we wanted to expand our participation this season.”

The schedule includes the Saints’ home opener on Sept. 11 against Livonia. The Wildcats defeated West Feliciana in the Class 3A playoff semifinals a year ago, 23-15, en route to winning the state championship. Although Livonia has moved up to Class 4A, the rematch promises to be competitive.

On Sept. 18, the Saints will host perennial Class 5A contender Live Oak in non-district action and KPCP will broadcast the contest. Three District 6-3A home games will also be broadcast live including Oct. 2 against Donaldsonville, Oct. 16 against Port Allen and the Nov. 6 regular season finale against Glen Oaks. The playoff schedule will be announced when those games are finalized.
